HISTORY & PURPOSE

The Crumley House Brain Injury Rehabilitation Center located in Limestone, TN was founded by June Barrett in 1992. Throughout the years, The Crumley House facilities and services have progressed to enable individuals who have experienced traumatic brain injuries the opportunity to live in the facility and participate in a day-training program that provides pre-vocational, vocational, cognitive training, physical, speech and occupational therapies as well as activities to enhance everyday living skills.

The services provided at The Crumley House help clients realize their maximum potential as they recover from devastating injuries caused by motor vehicles, sports, household accidents/falls, or other acquired brain injuries such as aneurysm and encephalitis.

Over 200 Crumley House brain-injured clients have been successfully rehabilitated and placed back into employment and greater independence. The Crumley House is constantly striving to raise funds in an effort to expand the facility and services due to the growing number of traumatic brain injury survivors in need of unique assistance in their second chance at life. Due to the uniqueness of traumatic brain injuries, it is not unusual for families to travel great distances to locate specialized rehabilitation programs to meet the needs of injured family members. The Crumley House addresses this devastating need.

A traumatic brain injury (TBI) is a blow, jolt or bump to the head or a penetrating head injury that disrupts the normal function of the brain.

1.7 million people, including 475,000 children, sustain a TBI in the United States each year. Additionally, 3.1 million individuals live with life-long disability as a result of TBI.
